

STOP the BNP'S Red, White & Blue festival



The police have invoked the Public Order Act and put a limit on the locations of protesters and restricted us to 700. As a consequence this is not the protest we would have wanted.

We expect the protest to be disciplined so that we can achieve an unambiguous, determined and peaceful protest both against the BNP and in support of local campaigners who have been working so hard against them.

NOTTS STOP THE BNP has already had much success in the local area. The campaign was successful in stopping Nick Griffin from hosting a BNP meeting in Kimberly October 07. In relation to the RWB Festival we have been working closely with local residents to ensure that every opportunity has been taken to show the BNP that they are not welcome in the East Midlands, such as lobbying Ripley council at the BNP's licensing application.

Our success is rooted in our strong links with the local community, the trade unions and support from a wide variety of groups.



The work of **NOTTS STOP THE BNP** does not stop here. We are committed to a continual campaign that widens participation in anti-fascist work and gains strength. We want to mobilise people in the labour movement, local campaigns and the community to challenge the BNP.
